Bible passage	Say: We are reading a story (that has been adapted) from the Bible today so that we can hear God's word and learn about Him.	Matthew 6:14-15 Use a pencil with an eraser on the end as a visual example of the mistakes we make. If I make a mistake with this pencil, I can use the rubber to remove the mark and carry on as though I hadn't made a mistake at all. We all make mistakes, I make lots, I don't mean to, it just happens. Other people make mistakes too and sometimes those mistakes hurt us. The mark with this pencil is easily rubbed out with this pencil, but if I made a mark with a pen that would be more difficult to remove. For us some mistakes are easy to forgive, like the pencil marks and some are much harder like pen marks. When we are truly sorry, God forgives our mistakes whether they are pencil or pen type mistakes. God wants us to forgive others in the same way whether they are easy or hard things to forgive. The rubber on this pencil will at some point run out, but God will keep on forgiving us, forever, and we should keep on forgiving others. Biblical link	Why it matters	Every time we say the Lord's prayer we say Forgive us our sins/ trespasses as we forgive those who sin/trespass against us. Today's passage states quite simply if you forgive others for the things they do wrong, then your Father in heaven will also forgive you for the things you do wrong. God wants us to forgive others and He will forgive us.		D =

Take away Say: How will you We make mistakes all the time so do other people, sometimes respond to the message response those mistakes hurt us. I wonder who has hurt you. we have heard from I wonder if you have forgiven them. This means truly God today? forgetting all about it. Can you put your paper chains on your wrists like handcuffs? By not forgiving others we hold a grudge against people, we stay angry with them and continue to feel hurt. This can wear us down and make us sad. Forgiving others breaks this chain of anger and hurt. Think about who you need to forgive, truly forgive them in your heart, which means you will not think of it again and now - break the chains. I wonder how you can show that person that they are forgiven. Say: We say prayers to Use a whiteboard and pens. Ask everyone to think of **Prayer** talk to God ... something they have done wrong and if they would like to, to come forward and mark the board in some way to represent that. Ask them to say sorry in their heads and then the leader will pray a prayer of forgiveness and wipe the board clean.
