We enclose a CD of the congregational songs used at the JC Eucharist. It makes things run more smoothly if those attending have had a go at singing the tunes before they arrive. Therefore we shall be grateful if the children coming to the JC day could learn the Gloria and the Sanctus on this CD before coming. We have enclosed a set of words; these will be displayed on the screen on the day, they need not be memorised.

NB. Please note that there are slight changes to the Gloria and substantial changes to the Sanctus.

During the service we will also sing 'Fill your hearts with Joy' number 9 in 'Come and Praise' tune 2.

NB. please read the notes before learning this song.

We hope that you might use the CD after the JC day to sing the Sanctus and Gloria again in school, 'Fill your hearts...' is for rehearsal only and should not be used.

In this hymn please note that we have changed the melody D in bar 8 to an F sharp. Listen carefully to the word 'divine' in verse 1.

At JC2010 the music will be played by the band. We suggest that you listen to the whole songs first and then use the other tracks if you need them. It is hoped that you will be able to sing along with just the accompaniments.

Please learn both parts to the Sanctus - you will only sing one part at JC BUT we cannot promise which at this stage!

The only difficulty with this song are the long rests in the last line. If you count beats like this...

Glory 2,3,4,1,2,3,4, Glory 2,3,4,1,2,3,4, Glory to God

...then you should get it right. The drums play on the practice track to help, they are not on the final accompaniment nor do they play at JC 2010—though we will have someone conducting!

Note the slight change of rhythm in the third verse to accommodate the extra syllable in Spirit.
