







Theme: The Holy Spirit helps us

Theme exploration:

The Bible talks about God the Holy Spirit, who helps the people here on earth to follow Jesus' example. In the Bible, we read that Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to help his followers do seemingly impossible things. John 14:26 'But the helper, the Holy Spirit, will be sent in my name, who will teach you all things and remind you of everything I (Jesus) have said to you.'

In the story, the whale gets confused by noisy motorboats zooming around on the surface. The whale loses his way and it's down to the tiny snail to save him. The snail, however, feels that she is weak and not capable of helping the whale, yet she is the only one who can save him. There is no way that the snail can help the whale on her own, instead she has to go and ask for help. This is what we believe the Holy Spirit does for us.

The Holy Spirit helps us to do the right thing, filling us with joy, peace and empowerment, giving us courage and strength to take on tasks that would be impossible on our own. The Holy Spirit comes to help us, when we ask.

'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson is a story about a restless young snail who wants to travel the world. The other snails think she should stay put, but she puts out a call, "Lift wanted around the world." Eventually her call is answered by a great big grey-blue humpback whale! She sets off with him across the seas. They discover towering icebergs and far-off lands, fiery mountains and golden sands.
