







Theme: "Knock, knock", said Jesus

Theme exploration:

The Bible contains many letters. The books in the Bible like Corinthians and Ephesians are letters to the churches in Corinth and Ephesus. Letters of love, support and challenge.

Letters are written to stay in contact with friends when you cannot meet in person. Jesus wants to be our friend. He wants us to knock on His door. The Bible in Luke says:

'Knock and the door will be opened to you' – Luke 1:9

Christians believe that this passage is to remind us how close God wants to be to us. God wants us to come to Him and pray to Him about our needs. He wants us to knock on His door, so that He can open the door to us. Will you knock?

'Postman Bear' is a lovely lift the flap book by Julia Donaldson and Axel Scheffler. Bear writes some letters and goes out to deliver them. He knows where everyone lives. Can you discover who lives in each home by lifting the flap? I wonder what the letters say?
