### Theme: Caring for others

# Theme exploration:

Isn't it nice the way that Dot was a friend to everyone in the story? Jesus loves everyone, He showed us how to value everyone when He was here on earth (*Mark 2:13-17*). This is how Jesus wants us to be. In the Bible Jesus said that we should treat other people like we want them to treat us. Now that's easy when we like the other person, but not so easy if the person is not our friend, is unkind to us or we have decided for some reason that we do not like them. We must remember that everyone is a part of God's creation and loved by Him.

Jesus asks us to 'love one another as I have loved you' (John 13:34). Jesus wants everything we do to be done out of love: this is not a soppy kind of love but about honouring and respecting people, even people we don't like! This kind of love doesn't expect anything back in return.

#### What you could do as a family this month:

- Draw a heart and add the names or pictures of all the people you know, even those people you do not like.

- Send a letter or picture to a friend or relative.
- Talk about times when others helped you. What did they do and why? Were they hoping for something in return?
