🞵 Theme: God knows your name

Isaiah 49:16

The bible says "I will not forget you! See, I have written your names on the palms of my hands".

What a wonderful thought that God knows each of our names and knows us individually.

D Theme exploration:

How long did you ponder the name of your child/ren?

Names are important; they are more than just ways to identify us as a person. Some names are linked to a relative or close friend and some people believe a child's name could be linked to their future success.

Names can have deeper meanings and the Bible tells how God has changed people's names. For example, Abram meaning "exalted father" became Abraham meaning "Father of many nations". God changed his name as a sign of the promise God made with him.

What could you do as a family this month?

- Use the internet to discover what each of your names mean?
- Notice the names you use for each other. What nicknames do you use?
- Make a bedroom door hanger with your child/ren's name(s) on it?
- Enjoy using your little one's names as you talk to them watch as they respond and maybe begin to learn their own name.
